

# **National Standards Target 2017**

# Reading

## Annual aim:

To increase the number of students achieving 'At' or 'Above' the National Standards for reading

#### **Baseline data:**

Analysis of school-wide reading data in November 2016 identified very positive results with virtually all year levels (and most gender groups) reaching over 90% 'At' or 'Above' standard.

Targets for students 'Above' standard were met for most year levels (and gender groups).

#### Special Target groups in 2017

2<sup>nd</sup> Year boys - those below standard and those 'At' who could be achieving 'Above' Year 4 boys - those below standard and those 'At' who could be achieving 'Above' Year 6 students - those 'At' who could be achieving 'Above' Any Years 1-6 students who were 'At' who could be achieving 'Above'

#### Targets for the end of 2017:

All students to be 'At' or 'Above' the National Standard at each year level 50% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard at the end of Yrs 5-6 45% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard after three years at school & at the end of Yr 4 40% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard after two years at school 30% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard after one year at school

# **National Standards Target 2017**

# Writing

#### Annual aim:

To increase the number of students achieving 'At' or 'Above' the National Standards for writing

## **Baseline data:**

Analysis of school-wide writing data in November 2016 identified generally positive results across year levels, with only Year 5 students (76%) and Year 6 students (75%) failing to achieve over 80% of students 'At' or 'Above' standard.

## Special Target groups in 2017

Year 6 students - those 'Below' standard and those 'At' who could be achieving 'Above'

Year 5 boys - those 'Below' standard

Year 4 boys - those 'At' standard who could be achieving 'Above'

3rd Year students - those 'At' standard who could be achieving 'Above'

2<sup>nd</sup> Year students - those 'At' standard who could be achieving 'Above'

Any Years 1-6 students who were 'At' who could be achieving 'Above'

## Targets for the end of 2017:

All students to be 'At' or 'Above' the National Standard at each year level 35% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard at the end of Yrs 5-6 30% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard after three years at school & at the end of Yr 4 25% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard after two years at school 20% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard after one year at school

To increase the number of students achieving 'At' or 'Above' the National Standards for mathematics

#### **Baseline data:**

Analysis of school-wide mathematics data in November 2016 identified positive results at all year levels, with only Year 5 students (78%) failing to achieve over 85% of students 'At' or 'Above' standard. Targets

## Special Target groups in 2017

Year 6 students - those 'Below' standard and those 'At' who could be achieving 'Above'

3<sup>rd</sup> Year girls - those 'At' standard who could be achieving 'Above'

2<sup>nd</sup> Year girls - those 'At' standard who could be achieving 'Above'

Any Years 1-6 students who were 'At' who could be achieving 'Above'

# Targets for the end of 2017:

All students to be 'At' or 'Above' the National Standard at each year level 40% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard at the end of Yrs 5-6 35% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard after three years at school & at the end of Yr 4 30% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard after two years at school 25% of students to be 'Above' the National Standard after one year at school
