Please note A \$5 delivery charge is automatically applied across the website platform. It will not be charged to these orders as they will be delivered to school. To remove this charge

- click on "direct credit" payment option, and deduct the \$5 from their order total.
- If you choose to pay with Credit Card, the \$5 will be automatically part of the total.

Please include your child's name and Room number in the address. Shirts will cost \$45

Pre-Christmas orders close on 17 December with delivery to school by Week 3 of Term 1.

Orders for 2019 close on February 22, 2019 with delivery to school in Week 7 of Term 1 (22 March).

Please be aware that shirts ordered after the February date will cost **\$55** and take up to **six weeks to arrive**.

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) in 2019

We have had an optional BYOD policy in our Year 5-6 classes for a number of years now.

The introduction of the BYOD policy over the past three years has given staff and students greater access to important learning tools which support our Coatesville School Learning Model.

This year we opened up the option for our Year 4 students to trial bringing their own devices. After examining a review of this trial, which included feedback from our Year 4 students, teachers and parents, the Board of Trustees have approved the recommendation that the trial continue into 2019 for our Year 4 students.
