ERO and HERO!



The Education Review Office (ERO) is the New Zealand government's external evaluation agency. They evaluate and report on the education and care of learners in all schools.

We **started our latest partnership with ERO late last year**. As we discovered, the process for working with ERO had changed substantially since our last review.

Previously ERO reviews were conducted over a few days with intensive discussions, classroom observations and a subsequent formulation of a report for sharing on their website.

Now it is a longer process where ERO and schools work together over a 2-3 year period to ensure compliance and an evaluation focus aiming to improve/enhance teaching & learning. You will be kept updated with how the review is proceeding.

HERO was launched last week! If you have any difficulties logging in or receiving communication please let the office know. The **majority of school communication will now come via HERO** - either as an email or to the HERO app depending on your preference.

One great HERO feature allows us to see levels of engagement with communication, including who has read each message. Very good info that we can track over time.
