The National Standards guide schools with student achievement expectations in Reading, Writing and Mathematics:

- *After one year at school*
- *After two years at school*
- *After three years at school*
- *By the end of Year 4*
- *By the end of Year 5*
- *By the end of Year 6*

All Year 1-3 students will have progress and achievement reports and conferences as close as practical to their **6 months, 1 year, 18 months, 2 years, 30 months and 3 years** of schooling dates. We will look to schedule these

Each class will have a reporting schedule that indicates the dates for progress and achievement reports and conferences for the year.

Year 4-6 students will have progress and achievement reports and conferences during the middle and the end of the year.
