This information was emailed to families yesterday ...

On Wednesday 31 May between 1-3pm all teachers who are members of the NZEI teachers' union will be meeting to discuss the latest employment offer from the Ministry of Education. These meetings will leave a number of classrooms in our school without a teacher for the afternoon on Wednesday.

So, to ensure we are able to provide supervision for a manageable number of students, we are encouraging as many parents/caregivers as possible to <u>collect children from their</u> <u>classroom at 1pm</u>. Thank you in advance to those parents/caregivers who will be able to collect children early.

With this support from parents/caregivers, we can keep the **school open for supervision** for any children who are not able to be picked up at 1pm. The children who are not picked up early will be supervised by staff and released at 3pm. Buses will run as normal too.

HERO - Progress Reporting in Term 2

PRESVILLE SCHOOL

Mid Year Reporting

As previously shared, there will be some changes to individual student progress reporting this year. **Progress reports will be shared digitally & exclusively through HERO** at the end of Term 2.

Progress reporting will feature **progress graphs and statements for reading, writing, mathematics** ('Number' and other strands) **and Coatesville Competencies** (Responsibility, Reflection & Respect) - **as well as a 'General Comment'** summarising progress. The progress information will **explicitly show your child's progress against stages of learning** corresponding to 'At', 'Above' or 'Below' an expectation for each year level. This will **clearly show progress over time**, with the graphs being added to twice per year.

Teachers are currently working through the process of making these judgements. The **assessment information used to determine progress judgements will be comprehensive** but this won't be made available for parents via HERO ... yet! BUT the **'goals'** your child has achieved, and their next steps, <u>will</u> become part of our <u>ongoing progress reporting</u> in the very near future.
