Alert Level 2

We are ready for opening at Alert Level 2 on Monday!

After another disruption to the year I am sure we all hope the rest of the year can proceed without further interruption. We will reopen in a very safe manner and hope to regain momentum with learning for all children as quickly as possible. We want to maximise the time left this year to achieve as much as we can.

Please read the **Alert Level 2 expectations** (attached to the newsletter email) carefully to understand how we will operate during Alert Level 2.

These were also emailed earlier this week.

You will be notified if any late changes to our plans are required by the Ministry of Health and/or Education.

We strongly encourage all students to return to school on Monday - unless they are sick or are required to self-isolate.

Buses

Current information is that our children do not have to wear face coverings when on the school buses. They do not interact with other students during our bus runs so this is not necessary.

Lateness

We ask all students to arrive at school on time in the morning - before the handbell rings (at 8.55am).

If your child misses the class roll at 9am they must go straight to the school office to be marked 'present' by office staff on the electronic roll.

If a student arrives after 9.15am a parent or caregiver will need to inform the school office that the child is now in school. This can be done by coming into the school office or calling the school and leaving a message on the absence line. Thank you for your assistance with this.

Monday Sausage Sizzle and Pizza Lunches

While we appreciate that this will be missed by our students and parents under Level 2 restrictions our parent volunteers are not able to run the Monday sausage sizzle or pizza lunches. They will resume when we are back at Level 1. Thank you for your understanding.

Parent-Student-Teacher Conferences: Wednesday 9 September

The conferences originally scheduled for Wednesday 12 August were unfortunately postponed due to Auckland moving into Alert Level 3.

These conferences have been rescheduled for **Wednesday 9 September** (2.15-5.30pm).

Hopefully these conferences will take place at Level 1 but if not then they will be managed according to relevant restrictions. The safety of staff, students and parents/caregivers will remain the priority.

All conferences previously booked have been transferred to the same time on **the new date - you do not need to rebook.**

If however you have not booked a conference and now wish to do so there is still some availability.

This event was scheduled for Friday 4 September.

Unfortunately this **event has been postponed**, due to Alert Level 2 restrictions and the plan for it to be completed outside of school grounds.

Please **do not** seek any funds for this event.

No alternative date for this event has been set and, due to restrictions and time constraints, it may not be possible to hold it this year. We will explore all options but there is a strong possibility it may be cancelled.

Teacher Only Day: Friday 25 September

This information was contained in a previous newsletter.

Last year when the Primary Teachers Collective Agreement was signed, each school was given eight days to designate as 'Teacher Only Days' to help alleviate teacher workload. There was acknowledgement that teachers required more designated, uninterrupted and collaborative time to meet and complete important responsibilities.

The Ministry of Education directed schools to use schedule these days over three years.

We have yet to use any of these days (with one year gone already).

We actually postponed our first proposed TOD in June after we returned from lockdown.

But we need to use one this term (and one later next term) to support our teachers which will directly support student progress and achievement.

Children's Community Dental Clinic Free for children 0-17 years

To our Auckland whānau With the change in COVID-19 alert levels to Level 3 across the Auckland region, the wellbeing of our community is paramount. Practicing guidelines set jointly by the Ministry of Health and Dental Council of New Zealand state that all routine dental treatment should be postponed. Therefore, the Children's Community Dental Service (Auckland Regional Dental Service) is only able to provide urgent and emergency dental care to children, once the child's condition has been assessed by a dental clinician over the phone. The Dental Council of New Zealand has further advised that if a child's dental condition can be accurately diagnosed

and effectively managed *without* needing to see the child in-person, then that is best. This means the child's dental condition may be able to be managed with medication alone. From 12 August 2020, we will have seven essential dental care clinics open across Auckland (please find the list below). Opening hours are Monday-Friday, 8am-4.30pm.

If your child is in pain or you have concerns about their teeth, please phone the nearest clinic to you from the list provided above. Our dental clinicians will be available to discuss your concerns with you and to make a plan for your child. If you need to contact a health professional outside our operating hours, please phone Healthline on 0800 611 116. We kindly request you do not present to the clinic unless you have phoned the clinic and have been offered an appointment. Please note that we are required to ask COVID-19 pre-screening questions prior to all children and their whānau attending an appointment in our dental clinics.
