

# **Student Progress Reporting**

Progress reports will be shared digitally & exclusively through HERO on Friday.

We are in the early stages of our 'HERO: Student progress reporting' implementation.

As such, it has brought about changes for everyone - teachers, students and parents/caregivers.

'Change' will require us to take a few steps to get our reporting to where we ultimately want it to be, but we have taken some big steps already and we are ready for the first phase.

A more comprehensive outline of the steps we are taking will be shared tomorrow via HERO.

But to reinforce previous information, this is what to expect on Friday:

<u>Progress graphs</u> for Reading, Writing, Mathematics ('Number'), Mathematics ('Measurement/Geometry/Statistics') and our key Coatesville Competencies: Responsibility, Reflection & Respect. Very visual information which will explicitly show your child's progress against stages of learning - corresponding to 'At', 'Above' or 'Below' the expectation for each year level.

**There will also be a final, personal 'General Comment'** summarising progress, with some mention made of all areas listed above.

And then we will look forward **'Student/Parent/Teacher conferences'** next term where more detail around strengths and next steps will be shared.
