Attendance: Justified vs Unjustified Absences

The MOE & ERO are currently very focused on maximising student attendance across the country, due to the concerning amount of learning time that can be lost over time.

So we are doing our best to make attendance expectations clear to our parents/caregivers.

With HERO <u>your child's attendance record is now very visible</u>. This includes all <u>half-days</u> 'present' and all 'justified' and 'unjustified' absences.

Justified absences: Medical reasons, doctor/dentist appointments, funeral or tangi Unjustified absences:

- Explained but unjustified reasons (ie. not school policy or principal approved)
- **Holiday during term time** (Note: Holidays of 5 school days or more, a parent/caregiver must complete an official 'Leave Form' which is directed to the office and the principal)
- If no reason is given

Please use HERO to report any absences - it is the easiest way to do it! For you and our staff!
