This message from Ritchies Bus Company is for all students who use the bus and are not eligible to ride the bus for free:

"With the increase in fuel and wages we will be **increasing the price of the yellow clip tickets to \$28 for 2023**. This is in line with the annual % increase per Transport Price Index from Waka Kotahi."

For \$28 you get a 10-ride ticket. These tickets must be paid for in cash to the driver.


