Options for pick-up:

Children will be able to be picked up at 1pm from their classroom.

If not, they will have lunch as usual and at 1.45pm they will go to the library.

From the library, between 1.45-3pm, children can be picked up for a conference or to go home.

At 3pm all remaining children need to be picked up from the assembly area. Children cannot be left at school unsupervised to play until their conference.
