

Coatesville Reserve

Adopt a Park School Programme (Auckland Council)

This came to fruition last week when Anna Baine came to Coatesville School to talk to us. On our visit to Coatesville Reserve with Anna, we identified many native trees and harmful weeds. She also found a place where we are planning on planting native trees next year. Our goal is for the school to plant native trees in the reserve every year.

Pest Free Coatesville

Earlier this term, Gary Langridge from Pest Free Coatesville came to school and gave an informative talk to four classes about what their group is doing to support our local environment. On Monday some Year 5 students were going to lay some possum traps with Gary in the Coatesville Reserve, but due to the weather this has been postponed. This will give students an opportunity to learn and take care of our local environment.
