



'Kotahitanga' is the concept of 'togetherness'. It means ...

- Unity
- Inclusiveness
- Working together to achieve common goals
- "Lifting each other up"
- Extending our **ā**whina (support) to others and receiving it back
- Connectedness
- "If you create winners **and losers**, you lose the spirit of kotahitanga"

In 2023 at Coatesville School we will use 'Kotahitanga' to focus our learning and behaviours. We will specifically focus on:

- Kotahitanga being a guiding concept during every day and every week of the year
- Formulating and implementing plans to support 'Kotahitanga' for staff, students, BOT and parents/caregivers



Water Safety NZ - Teacher Poolside Support

Last Thursday & Friday, all Coatesville teachers received poolside support/professional development from a coach from Swimming NZ.

This support is provided free by Water Safety NZ to enable teachers across NZ to effectively deliver the <u>Water Skills for Life programme</u>, of which our school swimming progressions are closely based.

Every class had a 30-45 minute session with a Swimming NZ coach where they modelled a lesson on an aspect that their teacher wanted to develop further. There was also an opportunity to ask follow up questions and gain insightful tips.

Buses - Ticket increase



This message from Ritchies Bus Company is for all students who use the bus and are not eligible to ride the bus for free:

"With the increase in fuel and wages we will be **increasing the price of the yellow clip tickets to \$28 for 2023**. This is in line with the annual % increase per Transport Price Index from Waka Kotahi."

For \$28 you get a 10-ride ticket. These tickets must be paid for in cash to the driver.
