Our waka will be used to support 'our learning journey' and be referenced in many ways - but, of course, it is primarily a unique playground for our children and the community to enjoy! In addition to the waka, there will be an adjacent play area built where 4 new pieces of equipment - monkey bars and transitional apparatus - will be also constructed to ensure that option is still available for those who love to swing & challenge themselves.
